CURRICULUM

Saint Ann School follows the curriculum of the Office of Catholic Education in compliance with the Ohio State Standards. The curriculum includes the study of:

- Religion
- Language Arts (Reading, English, Spelling and Writing)
- Mathematics
- Social Studies
- Science (including Health and Safety)
- Fine Arts (Art and Music)
- Physical Education
- Technology

All subjects of the K-8 curriculum are cyclical and sequential.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

The state-of-the-art Science and Technology Center offers students in all grades the opportunity to explore and develop the relationship between Science and Technology. Wireless laptops allow students access to the Internet for research. The scientific method is taught through inquiry-based learning. Data entry skills and analysis supplement hands-on activities. Power Point presentations are developed by the students.

Each classroom is equipped with a Smart Board and projector to enhance class instruction.
