

# 2011 Residential Recycling Report

## Dear Residents and Local Officials

This 2011 Residential Recycling Report documents the results of community recycling programs and composting programs in Cuyahoga County.

The information in this report was provided by each of the communities to the District. The recycling data include materials collected through curbside and drop-off recycling programs plus organic waste diverted from landfills through composting, brush chipping and other methods. In addition, recycling of special wastes such computers, appliances, scrap metal, household hazardous wastes and scrap tires were included in the recycling calculations.

Cuyahoga County is a leader in Ohio when it comes to waste reduction and recycling. Community recycling programs diverted nearly 30% of residential waste from landfills in 2011. This supported hundreds of recycling jobs, conserved natural resources, and saved communities money in landfill disposal fees.

Thank you to all the mayors, council persons, township trustees and service department employees for providing comprehensive recycling services to your residents. And thank you to all the conscientious residents for participating in these programs. Your efforts are making a difference.
